

## RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF MATRON

01. Name of the Post : **MATRON**
02. No. of Posts : As may be determined from time to time
03. Classification : Group 'C'
04. Scale of pay : Consolidated salary of Rs. ~~3000/-~~ <sup>7500/-</sup> per month (pre revised)
05. Whether Selection or non-selection post : N.A.
06. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible under 30 of CCS (Pension Rules), 1972 : N.A.
07. Age limit for direct recruits : Between 35 and 50 years
- Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits : Pass Class X
- Whether age and educational qualifications for direct recruits will apply to promotees : N.A.
- Period of probation. If any : N.A.
08. Method of rectt. Whether by direct recit. or by promotion or by deputation/transfer & percentage of vacancies to be filled by various methods : On contract initially for a period of one year renewal on year to year basis subject to a maximum of five years. Further extension will be given with the prior approval of Commissioner, NVS.

### **Note:**

1. In case candidates with above qualifications are not available, candidates having passed class 8<sup>th</sup> may be considered for appointment in which case they would be paid consolidated salary of @ Rs. ~~3000/-~~ <sup>7500/-</sup> per month.
2. The post will be non-transferable.
3. Only female candidates would be appointed as Matrons. All things being equal preference will be given to war widows, widows of Govt. servants who have died in harness and ladies without encumbrances.
4. Matrons will ordinarily not be appointed through the Employment Exchange but candidates would be interviewed from the list of lady candidates obtained from the District authorities/departments under the Ministry of Defence/Home Department of respective State Govts./reputable agencies working for the welfare of war widows/widows of victims of terrorist activities etc.
